

## Your absentee ballot procedure

If you're registered to vote in Alabama you can cast an absentee ballot if you:

- will be absent from the county on election day;
- are ill or have a physical disability that prevents a trip to the polling place;
- are a registered voter living outside the county, such as a member of the armed forces, a voter employed outside the United States, a college student, or a spouse or child of such a person;
- are an appointed election officer or poll watcher at a polling place other than his or her regular polling place;
- work a required shift, 10 hours or more, that coincides with polling hours.

Follow these simple steps to make sure your vote counts:

### Request an absentee ballot:

Complete the Absentee Ballot application furnished on this page. Be certain to designate which party, Republican or Democrat, run-off you're voting in, sign the application and send it to your county's absentee election manager.

Addresses for every county are listed to the right. You must be certain the application is received by the election manager by July 8, but it's best not to wait, you can send your application today.

Upon receipt and review of your absentee application, the election manager will mail you an absentee ballot for voting. This usually takes several days.

### Ballot procedure:

The absentee ballot comes with three envelopes: one plain (the secrecy envelope); one with an affidavit (or oath) printed on the outside; and one plain envelope, pre-addressed on the outside.

Once the voter casts the ballot, the procedure is as follows:

1. Seal the ballot in the plain envelope.
2. Place the plain envelope inside the accompanying affidavit envelope.
3. Seal the affidavit envelope and complete the affidavit that is on the outside of the envelope.
4. Sign the affidavit and have the signature witnessed by either a notary public or two witnesses 18 years of age or older.
5. Place the affidavit envelope and a copy of voter identification inside the outer envelope.
6. Remember to place a copy of your I.D., not the original, inside the outer envelope.

### Witness or notarization:

An absentee ballot cannot be counted unless the affidavit is notarized or has the signatures of two witnesses.

The voter has only the following legal ways to return the absentee ballot:

- Forward the absentee ballot by U.S. mail, or
- Personally hand the absentee ballot to the absentee election manager or deliver it by a designee in the case of emergency absentee voting.

### Voting deadline

An absentee ballot returned by mail must be postmarked no later than the day prior to the election, July 12th, and received by the absentee election manager no later than noon on election day. If hand-delivered, the ballot must be in the office of the absentee election manager by the close of business, but no later than 5 p.m. on the day prior to the election July 12th.

## Important Dates:

**July 8: Deadline for receipt by the absentee election manager of your application for an absentee ballot. Be sure to mail your application well ahead of this date.**

**July 12: Last day to postmark your absentee ballot for return to the absentee election manager. Be sure to return your ballot well ahead of this date.**
